The activities involve government agencies, nonprofit organizations, industry trade associations, and individual companies that are participating in America Saves Week (ASW), which runs from Feb. 22 through March 1, this year. The organizations have centralized a diverse collection of savings tips, tools, public service announcements, and saver stories on the ASW Web site, www.americasavesweek.org/. Among other things, the Web site offers individuals the opportunity to sign up for monthly saver e-mail messages that will allow them to test their knowledge of various saving techniques and a checklist to evaluate their savings progress.
