Q: My team has their CRPS ? What ASPPA exam would be appropriate to compliment what we already have?

A: For professionals who focus on investments and/or sales/marketing or support of those areas, the QPFC is the credential we would recommend. A CRPS will receive a waiver of the RPF-1 and RPF-2 exams for purposes of acquiring the QPFC credential, so the candidate would only need to successfully pass the advanced exams, PFC-1 and PFC-2 and meet the experience requirements to receive a QPFC.

Q: Are the RPF's eligible for CFP CE?

A: Yes, RPF webcourses and exams are eligible for CFP CE. Please check the current CFP guidelines to determine the appropriate number of credits.

Q: Do you know how many hours of CE you can earn from ASPPA's RPF webcourses?

A: Each RPF web course consists of 7 modules. (There are 14 in total for RPF-1 and RPF-2 combined.) Each module is approximately 50-60 minutes long, designed to count for 1 hour of ASPPA CE. Each RPF exam counts for 7.5 hours of ASPPA CE.

Q: How about Insurance Licensing CE? Do you know if this counts for this in Indiana?

A: Each state has different requirements. ASPPA programs are not pre-approved by any state insurance licensing board. Once a candidate has determined the state requirements, the candidate can contact the ASPPA office for additional assistance in obtaining any additional program information needed to support the candidate's application to the state.

Q: Is one has the CRPS designation, does that waive the RPF exams regardless what path one may be pursuing?

A: The current ASPPA policy is that RPF exams are waived for CRPS designees only for purposes of pursuing the QPFC credential.
